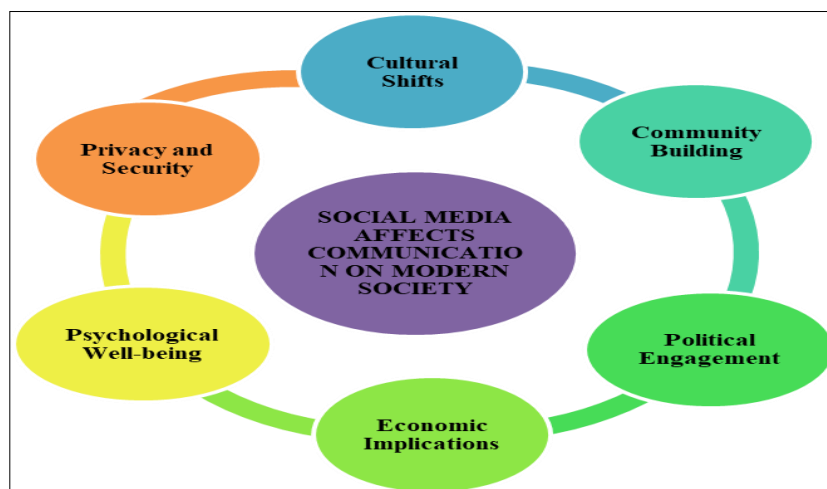

Privacy and Security Issues

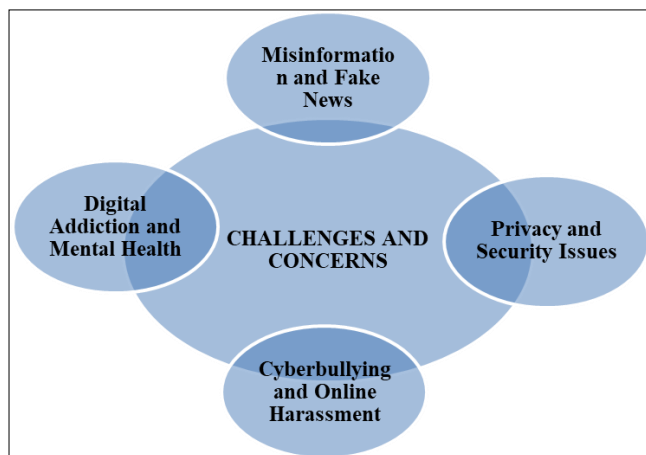

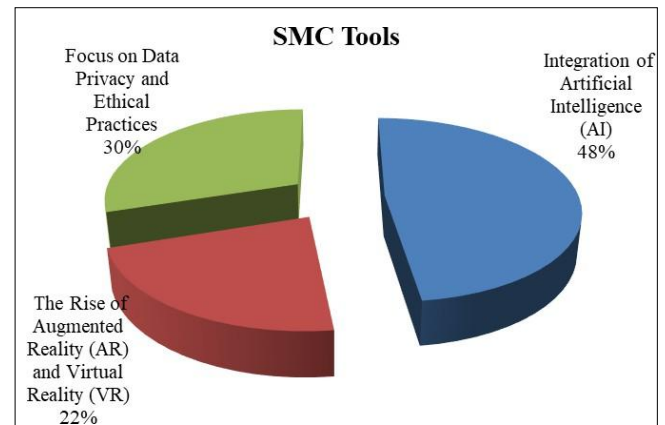
The Rise of Augmented Reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR)
